The following Order of President of India, G.S.R 591(E), dated: the 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2016 published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part-II, Section-3, Sub-Section (i) is republished:

THE ANDHRA PRADESH PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT (ORGANISATION OF LOCAL CADRES AND REGULATION OF DIRECT RECRUITMENT) AMENDMENT ORDER-2016.

**ORDER**

**G.S.R.591(E)-** In exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (1) and (2) of article 371 D of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following Order further to amend the Andhra Pradesh Public Employment ( Organisation of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order,1975, namely:-

1. (1) This Order may be called the Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organisation of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Amendment Order, 2016.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organisation of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order,1975, in paragraph 7 after sub-paragraph (2) and before the Explanation, the following sub-paragraph shall be inserted, namely:-

" (3) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-paragraph (1) or (2), candidates who migrate to any part of the State of Andhra Pradesh from the State of Telangana within a period of three years from the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 2014 shall be regarded as the local candidate in the State of Andhra Pradesh at the place of his residence and be treated at par with the local candidates residing in that area, in accordance with such guidelines as may be issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh for the purpose of employment."

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The attention of all the Departments of the Secretariat and the Chief Commissioner of Land Administration & Ex.Officio Spl.C.S to Govt., is invited to the references cited and they are informed that during meetings, discussions, and Video conference held with the concerned officials for operationalization of guidelines for issue of Local Status Certificate to the applicants by the Tahsildars, through Mee-Seva Portal in terms of instructions issued vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited, following issues have been raised or brought to the notice of the Govt.,:-

- i) **Mentioning of Caste in Form.III at Serial No.6:-**Majority of the officials opined that mentioning the caste of a person in Form.III would lead to complications as that may be used as a document for claiming regular caste certificate. Secondly, it has been pointed out that certain castes are SCs in Andhra Pradesh and BCs in Telangana State or vice versa or otherwise.
  - ii) **Mentioning of Previous Study Particulars:-** Another aspect that has been brought to notice of the Govt., is that in Form.III, there is no mention about the previous study particulars. In the absence of previous study particulars of applicant, there is a scope for someone from Andhra Pradesh temporarily migrating to Telangana and coming back to AP and claiming the certificate as Local afresh without mentioning that he is already a local to Andhra Pradesh. This situation may arise in case of persons trying to obtain a Local Status Certificate in certain places /zones where competition may be less compared to certain other places for education / employment.
  - iii) **Enclosing photograph on Form. III & To introduce Aadhar No. of parent or guardian in Form.II: to prevent its misuse.**
- 2) After careful and thorough examination of the above issues, Government hereby clarifies on issue (i) that 'Caste' shall be mentioned in Form.III. However, the very purpose of the application of the applicant in Form.I and the **Certificate in Form.III is to confirm the local status of the applicant only.** Therefore, at the end of Form.III (now revised) it is clearly mentioned that the certificate in Form.III confirms only local status of the applicant and it **does not confirm the rest of the information in the certificate.** Besides on issue (ii) and (iii), it is decided to include:- (a) Previous Study Particulars of applicant in Form.I and Form.III from Class-IV to X (b) Affixing of Photograph of applicant in Form.III duly generating from Form.II and (c) Indicating Aadhar No. of parent or guardian in Form. II. Accordingly, the Forms issued vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited have been revised and appended to this Memo for uploading the same in mee-seva portal for issue of Local Status Certificate.
- 3) The Revenue Department, being the competent authority to issue Local Status Certificate, shall operationalize and monitor the implementation of the guidelines issued vide Circular Memo.No.4136 / SPF&MC / 2015-5, dt: 8.8.2016 together with the clarification brought out in this Memo.

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- 4) The CCLA & E.O. Spl. Chief Secretary to Govt., and Revenue Department are requested to give instructions to all the Tahsildars and other revenue functionaries under the control of Revenue Department for implementation of the Guidelines together with the clarifications aforesaid scrupulously and to issue local status certificates to the applicants accordingly within the prescribed time limit.

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The attention of all the Departments of the Secretariat / HoDs is invited to the references cited and they are informed that Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India vide reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited amended the Presidential Orders-1974 and 1975 meant for Education and Employment by inserting subparagraph (3) in Paragraph 4 and Paragraph 7 of the said Orders, respectively. The same were published vide references 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> cited in Andhra Pradesh Gazette Notifications.

2. They are also informed that in the reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited, the Government have published the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions) Amendment Order, 2016, *inter alia*, based on reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited, as follows:

*In the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions) Order, 1974, in paragraph 4 after sub -paragraph (2) and before the Explanation, the following sub-paragraph shall be inserted, namely:-*

*"(3) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-paragraph (1) or (2), a candidate who migrates to any part of the State of Andhra Pradesh from the State of Telangana within a period of three years from the 2nd day of June, 2014 shall be regarded as the local candidate in the State of Andhra Pradesh at the place of his residence and be treated at par with the local candidates residing in that area, in accordance with such guidelines as may be issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh for the purpose of education".*

3. Further, in the reference 5<sup>th</sup> cited, Government have published the Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Amendment Order, 2016, *inter alia*, based on reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited above as follows:

*In the Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 1975, in paragraph 7 after sub-paragraph (2) and before the Explanation, the following sub-paragraph shall be inserted, namely:-*

(P.T.O)

"(3) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-paragraph (1) or (2), candidates who migrate to any part of the State of Andhra Pradesh from the State of Telangana within a period of three years from the 2nd day of June, 2014 shall be regarded as the local candidate in the State of Andhra Pradesh at the place of his residence and be treated at par with the local candidates residing in that area, in accordance with such guidelines as may be issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh for the purpose of employment".

4. In pursuance of the powers vested upon in the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited, the Government of Andhra Pradesh, hereby issue the following guidelines in the matter:

- (a) A candidate, intending to make an application for admission in Higher Educational Institutions in the State of Andhra Pradesh or an application for direct recruitment to a post to which the scheme of reservation to a local candidate applies, wants to be treated at par with the local candidates residing in that area in terms of the amendments issued in the references 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> cited, has to furnish an application along with declaration in the Forms-I & II respectively, annexed to these guidelines containing the details of his/her migration to the State of Andhra Pradesh from the State of Telangana within a period of 3 years from the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 2014.

In case of minors, the parent /guardian has to also furnish a declaration (Form-II annexed).

- (b) The candidate, who migrates from the State of Telangana to the State of Andhra Pradesh within the prescribed time limit has to furnish self-attested copies of proof of his residence in the State of Telangana (i.e., any one of the document viz., Aadhar Card, Driving License, Ration Card, Bank Pass Book, Pan Card, Voter ID card and any other valid certificates) which are accepted as proof of residence in force.
- (c) The Candidate, who migrates from the State of Telangana to the State of Andhra Pradesh within the above time limit also has to furnish self-attested copies of proof of residence in Andhra Pradesh by a declaration along with any one of the documents viz., Aadhar Card, Driving License, Ration Card, Bank Pass Book, Pan Card, Voter ID Card and any other certificates which are accepted as proof of residence in force.
- (d) The Candidate, who intends to apply for admission into Educational Institutions/Employment as stated above, shall make an application in Form-I on line to the Tahsildar concerned, on or before 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2017, through "Mee-Seva" Portal or any other portal to be notified in due course. Basing on the documents furnished, the Tahsildar shall issue the Local Status Certificate in the proforma prescribed with digital signature within (7) days from the date of receipt of the application online in Form-III annexed to these guidelines, failing which a Local Status Certificate will be generated automatically in the Portal in the name of concerned Tahsildar.

- (e) In case the information furnished by the candidate is found false, his / her admission to such course or selection to the post shall stand cancelled and the candidate shall be liable for prosecution.

5. The above guidelines are issued strictly in adherence to the provisions of the Presidential Orders meant for both Education & Employment, wherein it has been stipulated that, "whether any candidate for admission to any course of study or for direct recruitment to any post has resided in any local area shall be determined with reference to the places where the candidate actually resided and not with reference to the residence of his/her parent or other guardian".

6. All the Departments of Secretariat /HoDs/ District Collectors and all concerned shall take necessary action, accordingly.

Sub: G.A.(SPF&MC) Dept.- Issuance of Local Status Certificates in terms of the Amendment Orders issued to the Presidential Orders meant for Education & Employment as per the Guidelines issued vide Circular Memo No.4136/SPF&MC/ 2015-5, dt: 8.8.2016- Revival of the Service as further extension of time for two more years has been extended by the GoI- Revised Instructions - Issued.

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The attention of all the Departments of A. P. Secretariat and HODs is invited the references cited and they are informed that Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India amended the Presidential Orders-1974 and 1975 meant for Education and Employment by inserting subparagraph (3) in Paragraph 4 and Paragraph 7 of the said Orders, respectively for treating a candidate who migrates to any part of the State of Andhra Pradesh from the State of Telangana within a period of three years from the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 2014 as the local candidate in the State of Andhra Pradesh at the place of his residence and be treated at par with the local candidates residing in that area, in accordance with such guidelines as may be issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh for the purpose of education & employment.

2. Accordingly, vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited Government issued Guidelines prescribing detailed procedure for obtaining local status certificates through "Mee-seva" duly fixing the time limit for application (i.e) on or before 1<sup>st</sup> June 2017. (Para 4 (d) of the Guidelines). The same continued till 1<sup>st</sup> June 2017 and vide reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited the service is being stopped from the forenoon of 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2017 till further orders.

3. It is further informed that based on the request of the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India have further amended the Presidential Orders 1974 & 1975 meant for Education and Employment by extending the above time limit for obtaining local status to the candidates who ever migrate to Andhra Pradesh from Telangana for two more years from the appointed day (i.e) from 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2014 to on before 1<sup>st</sup> June 2019. The same are republished vide reference 5<sup>th</sup> cited. As such the earlier practice of issuing local certificates through "Mee-seva" as per the Guidelines issued vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited has to be revived. And the time limit prescribed in para 4 (d) of the Circular Memo.No.4136/SPF&MC/2015-5, dt: 8.8.2016 is also hereby extended to on or before 1<sup>st</sup> June 2019 in tune with the latest amendments issued to the Presidential Orders-1974, 1975 by GOI and the rest of the guidelines remain unchanged. Accordingly, the Candidate, who intends to apply for admission into Educational Institutions / Employment as stated above, shall make an application in Form-I (appended to the earlier Guidelines) on line to the Tahsildar concerned, on or before 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2019, through "Mee-Seva" Portal. And the Tahsildar shall issue the Local Status Certificate (Form-III) with digital signature within 7 days of receipt of the application failing which a Local Status Certificate will be generated automatically in the Portal in the name of concerned Tahsildar as per the earlier practice in vogue.

4. All the Departments of Secretariat /HoDs/ District Collectors and all concerned shall take necessary action, accordingly.
